


Map: Ogallala Aquifer Water Supply at Risk from Keystone XL Reroute



A depth-to-water map of Nebraska, with the original Keystone XL route in orange. Areas in light blue have a high water table (depth to water 0 to 50 feet) and are more vulnerable to an oil spill. Areas in dark blue have a depth to water of over 50 feet. The new route will likely pass through northern Holt County.
